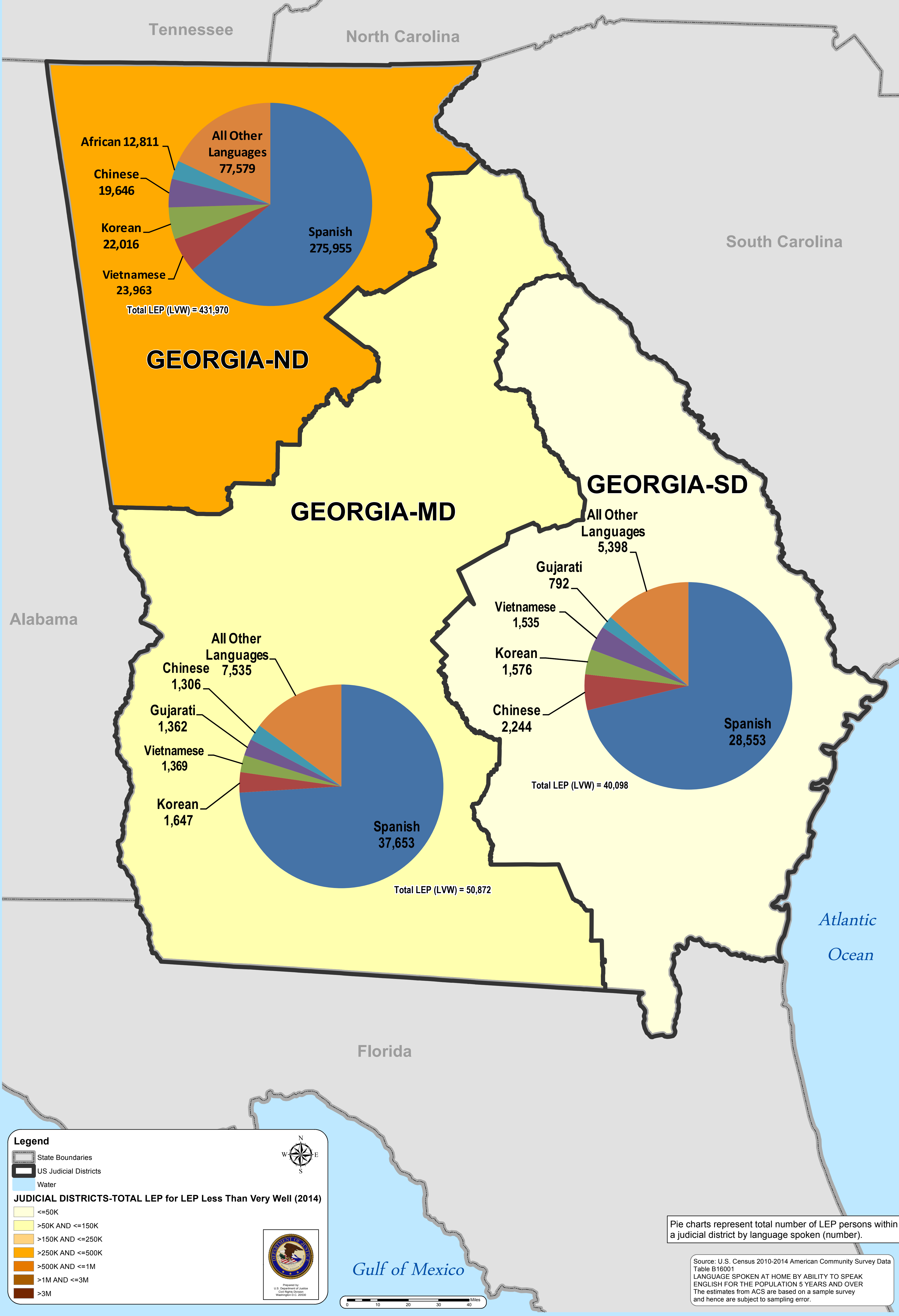


# U.S. Judicial Districts - State of Georgia (2014)

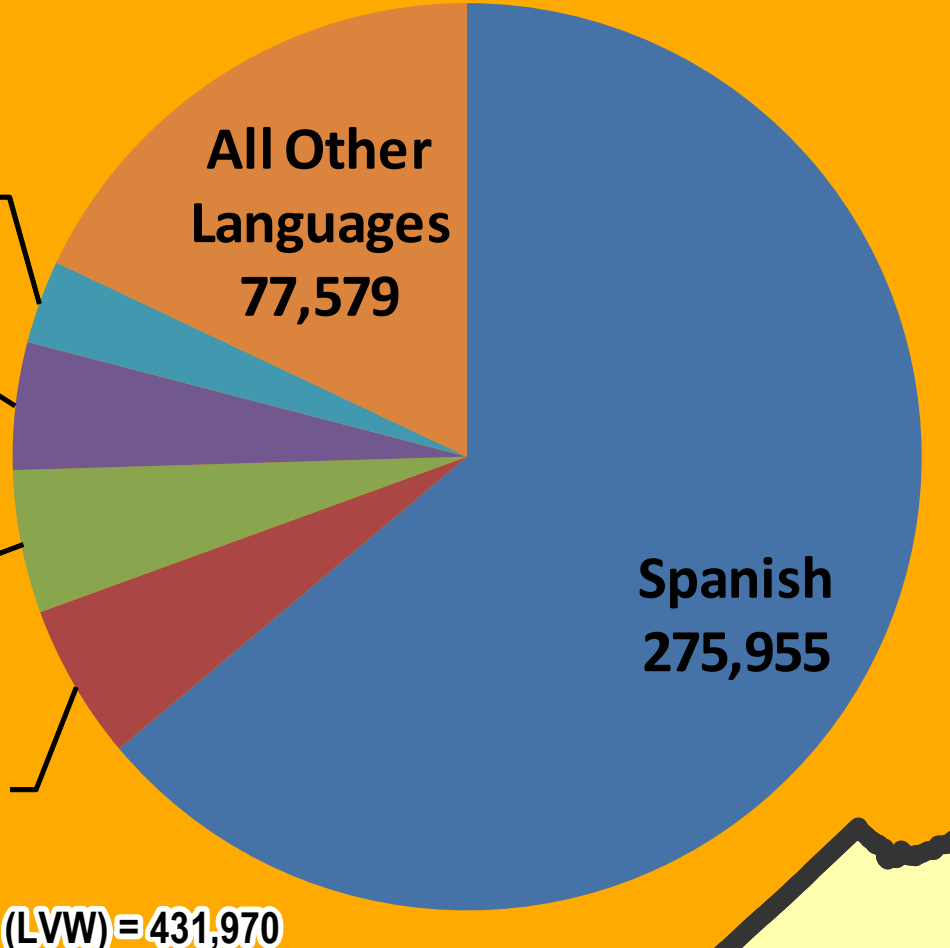
## Total Persons 5 Years and Over Who Speak a Language Other Than English at Home and Speak English Less Than "Very Well"

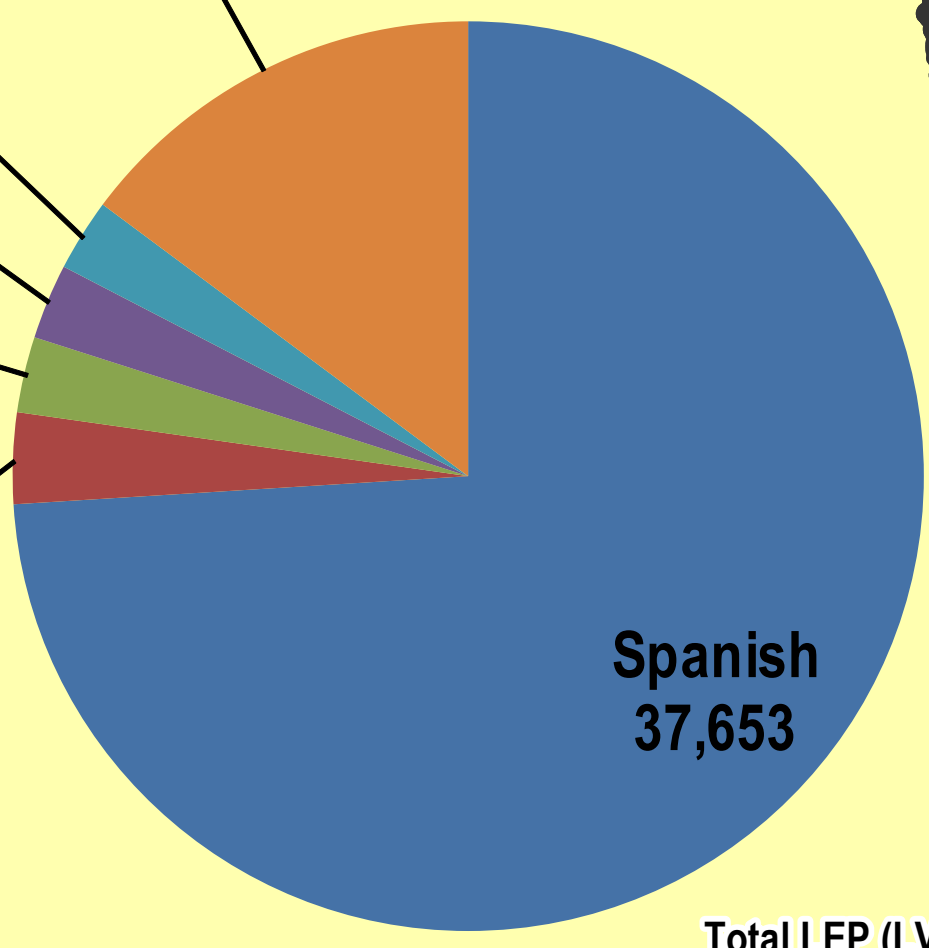

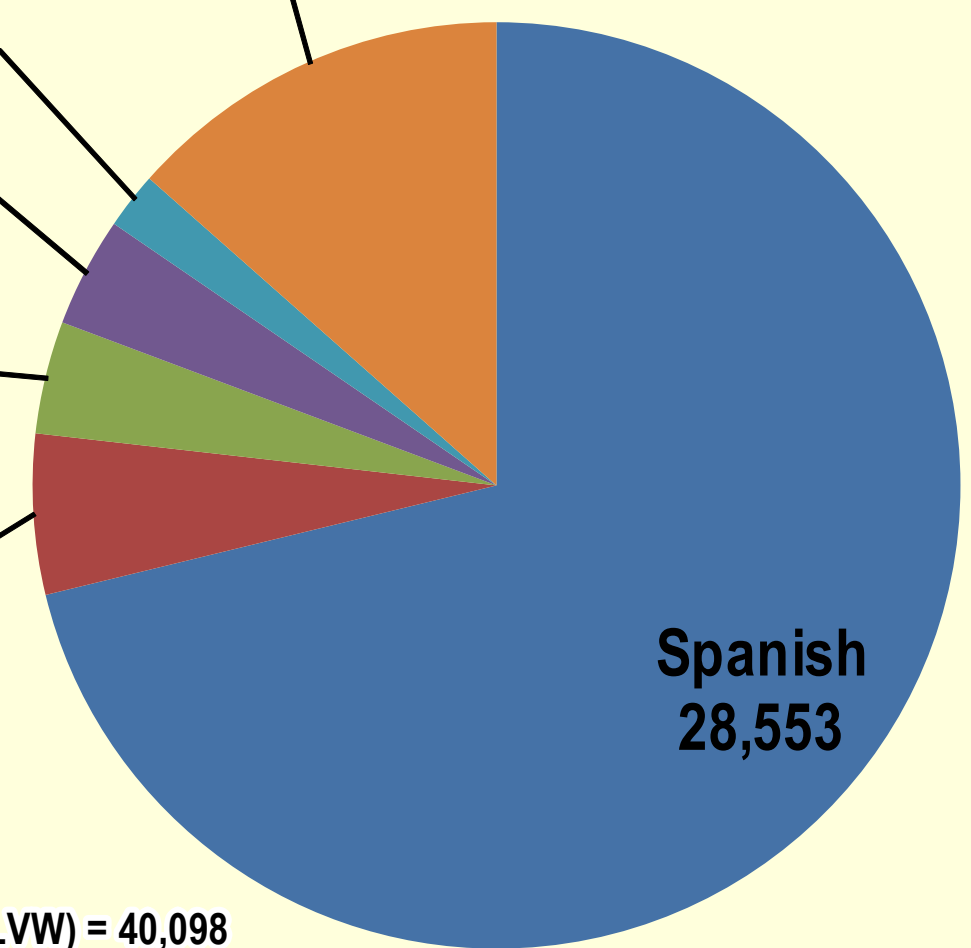
